This course is for learners who wish to develop applied knowledge and practical skills in Child Development. We look at a child's development from birth up until the age of 5.

What will I learn on this course?

Reproduction, parental responsibility, antenatal care, birth, postnatal check-ups, postnatal provision, conditions for development, childhood illnesses and safety. Students will also gain knowledge of the equipment needs of babies and young children and understanding the factors to consider when choosing appropriate equipment. Students will also gain knowledge on the developmental norms from birth to five years and the stages and benefits of play.
